******A note to librarians: This was my schedule for 2007 and 2008. I did the same program for each daycare, with a new program each week. I usually had two sessions, and repeated programs for each session. I only created 5 programs and ran each program at each daycare once. The exception was Kansas Reads to Preschoolers Week, where the program was unique to whatever daycare I was visiting that particular week in November.

Your record of books and activities done may include more detail, especially if a different librarian will be doing these programs in a few years. It's a good idea to keep a printout of this document in a file with copies of activity pages or complete bibliographic information on the books, CD's, or activity books used. If there is no hyperlink listed below, I drew an activity page for the children. Preschoolers are no art critics, so do not hesitate to create your own book-related activity pages if you have something in mind and can't find a suitable printable.
